The starting procedure, course and finish lines (yes, more than one) can be confusing, so read the sailing instructions.

This year will be both the Maricat National Titles and PT State Pointscore. The club has promised us a dedicated 14' cat start line. Around 90 boats of many different types have entered in the past few years.
